

Ms. Demartino's testimony that the allonge was prepared belatedly and as a result of litigation is not even the most damning part of the fraud. The stamped facsimile signatory on the allonge from 2008 is David A. Spector, a top Countrywide executive who left the company in 2006. How is it possible that Mr. Spector caused his name to be affixed by a stamped signature in 2008 when he wasn't working for Countrywide. It is believed by Mark Malone and myself that the signature was affixed by someone other than Spector and is therefore a forgery.
